SafeAssign is plagiarism prevention tool that promotes academic integrity with your student's homework submissions.

- ✓ Checks the originality of homework submission to identify areas of overlap with other submissions.
- ✓ Compares the student's assignment against several databases
 - 1. **Global Reference Database**: Contains over 15 million papers volunteered by students from Blackboard client institutions to help prevent cross-institutional plagiarism
 - 2. **Institutional document archives:** Contains all the papers submitted to SafeAssign by users in their respective institutions
 - 3. **Internet:** Searches across the broader internet for matching text using an internal search service
 - 4. **ProQuest ABI/Inform Journal Database:** More than 3,000 publication titles, 4.5 million documents, and over 200 topical categories

ONCE SUBMITTED SAFEASSIGN:

Generates Originality Reports. These reports:

- ✓ Contain details the percentage of text in the submitted paper that matches existing sources.
- ✓ Identify all matching blocks of text. Instructors and students need to determine if the matching text is properly referenced.
- ✓ Display the list of potential sources, and each source is highlighted in a different color. The report can display up to 30 colors to represent 30 different sources.

INTERPRETING THE RESULTS:

Once you receive your SafeAssign originality report for your student's submissions, it's important to understand how you can interpret the results.

- A score of less than <15% typically include some quotes and few common phrases or blocks of text that match other documents. These papers generally do not require further analysis.
- A score of 15% to 40% include extensive quoted or paraphrased material and/or they may include plagiarism. These papers should be reviewed to determine if the matching content is properly attributed.

• A score of greater then >40% has a very high probability that text in this paper was copied from other sources. These papers include quoted or paraphrased text in excess and should be reviewed for plagiarism.

- SafeAssign does not support spreadsheet files.
- SafeAssign also accepts ZIP files and processes files that match of these file types.
