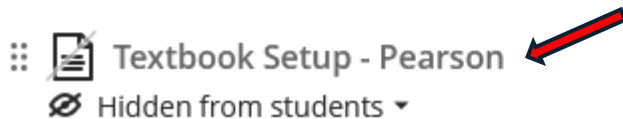
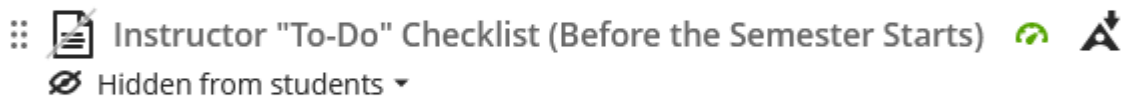
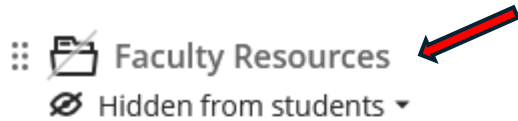


Textbook Instructions for **Section Instructors**

PEARSON LTIA – Part I: Textbook Setup and Course ID

1. If you have not already done so, create a Pearson account at: <https://mycourses.pearson.com/> or contact LEID for assistance.
2. Find the textbook setup information under **the Faculty Resources → Textbook Setup Instructions – Cengage** of the Master Course.
